Agenda for Conference Call

1. Capping of conference funds to chapter

Based on discussions over the past few weeks, the EC unanimously approved the proposal to cap the chapter share from this and all future conferences at 10 lakhs. The rest of the profits to be returned to the centre for office functioning and funding research and educational agendas planned.

This is predicated on a few assumptions-

- The conference held every alternate year, therefore the shortfall of funds needs to be made up
- Office functioning and other yearly costs need to be funded on a biennial basis
- Both chapter and centre need to benefit for financial stability

From all monies raised for the conference, the host chapter will continue to share 20% of the gross amount raised with the centre, up to a maximum amount of 10 lakhs.

All monies raised from chapter events will be remain with the chapter.

2. Awards ceremony at AGM or Conference

It was agreed that even though the conference has a larger audience for the awards ceremony, non-conference year awards should be handed out at the AGM. This may bring more members to the AGM, which is an important milestone the ISOLA calendar. The awards of that year may be screened at the conference in addition to the conference year awards.

Awards at the conference to be held at the end of Day 1. Award winners, jury and convenor to be hosted by Kerala chapter i.e., chapter hosting the conference. This includes travel and hotel accommodation for 2 days. Registration is not complimentary.

3. Conference update

Kerala conference venue has been shifted to Kochi and will be held on February 15 – 16th, 2019. The conference website will be set up through the main ISOLA website and the call for papers released soon. Nikhil and Rajesh on the content committee are setting up a multi- workshop format for the conference. Logistics related to multiple sessions to be addressed and time taken to move people in and out of spaces to be accounted for.

Registration fees can be increased by Rs.500 for each category. LOC to confirm.

4. Change of signatories on conference account

Based on changes to the LOC, the signatories on the ISOLA Conference Account A are Sebastian Jose (Convenor), Ganga Krishnan, Krishnakumar and Anish Nair.

5. IFLA handouts/ graphics/ posters

Jasleen and the Delhi chapter have taken the initiative to develop a poster on ISOLA for the IFLA World Congress to be held in Singapore on July 18-19th, 2018 where ISOLA has a complimentary kiosk. Conference convenor Sebastian will coordinate graphic displays with them, including poster of the conference and handouts being developed by Brij.

6. NASA (workshops and video)

Nidhi Madan met with the NASA president, treasurer and Zone 6 representative to discuss possible collaborations in addition to the trophy. NASA is focusing on documentation and developing student skills not taught in college curriculum and look forward to ISOLA interaction and engagement towards developing student's interest in landscape architecture.

7. ISOLA Calendar

Maharashtra chapter meeting will be held on 21st July to set up their managing committee and elect office bearers.

8. Chapter videos

None received. Anju Bareja suggested a common format across chapters. Narasimham V.L. suggested videos be developed at the conference similar to those done at the NVV Indian Plumbing Association and a budget be allocated to it.

9. AGM

AGM will be held on September 8th, 2018, and the EC meeting the day before, i.e., September 7th, 2018.

10. IGBC event

IGBC has invited ISOLA to partner with them for a Seminar on Green Landscape and Biodiversity, on Day 3 of their Green Building Congress 2018 to be held at HICC, Hyderabad from Oct 31st-Nov 3rd, 2018 as one of concurrent seminars. Programme and speakers to be suggested by ISOLA.
